Please be courteous to the owners/operators of Nor Mar Farm. We work closely with them to create the most productive rehabilitative program for your horse but ask for a few specific rules to be adhered to.

- 1. Hind shoes are not permitted on the aqua tread.
- 2. The facility asks that you are up to date on EIA testing (coggins), Flu/Rhino and Streptococcus Equi (strangles) vaccines.
- 3. No dogs are permitted on the premises. There are no exceptions, please do not bring your dogs with you to the farm as they will not be permitted out of your vehicle. There are horses on strict stall rest at the facility that may be excited by any extra activity.
- 4. Any special feeding requirements need to be discussed and agreed upon with Nor Mar Farm as to any additional charges that may apply.
- 5. Due to training protocols it is preferred that you not attend your horse in the treadmill until the facility believes they have acclimated. They will notify you when your horse is ready to be seen training.
- 6. The facility runs on a specific schedule. If you plan to visit your horse, please give ample notice of planned arrival time so that they are prepared to welcome you.
- 7. The barn is CLOSED on Sunday to any visitors.
- 8. If your horse is not already body clipped in winter, please do so before arrival. All horses must be clipped to dry after training, if they are not, they will not be introduced to the water until the facility has had time do so for a fee of their choosing.
